- director for or any disbursement prior to performance. 1 2 DELEGATE MARSHALL: Do I have a second? Second. MR. PACE: 5 DELEGATE MARSHALL: Any discussion? 6 (No response.) 7 Hearing none --DELEGATE MARSHALL: 8 SENATOR MORRISSEY: If we didn't 9 approve the \$10 million, would that mean that my 10 colleague Senator Ruff is on the hook for that \$10 million, which he previously gave them tentative 11 12 approval? 13 SENATOR RUFF: That might be correct. 14 This was re-opened so that if things 15 change as, you know, and/or loan and all of that 16 stuff.
- DELEGATE MARSHALL: The reason we're
- doing it now is because we are all here together.
- 19 Then we don't have to have a special meeting like we
