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- 2 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
- 3 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Come to order. We're
- 4 running behind here. Welcome and thank y'all for
- 5 coming.
- Andy, call the roll please.
- 7 MR. SORRELL: Yes, sir, Chairman
- 8 Ruff.
- 9 Senator Ruff. Delegate Morefield.
- 10 Delegate Adams. Mr. Blevins. Delegate Byron. She
- 11 just went to get some coffee. We'll call her again.
- 12 Ms. Hensley. Delegate Kilgore. Delegate Lucas.
- 13 Delegate Marshall. Mr. Miles, remotely. Mr. Shelton.
- 14 You have the floor, Mr. Chairman.
- 15 DELEGATE MOREFIELD: I move that
- 16 Chairman Ruff's approval of Commissioner Miles'
- 17 request to participate remotely in this meeting is in
- 18 conformance with Commission's adopted electronic
- 19 meeting policy, and that the voices of the remote
- 20 participating members will be heard by all persons at
- 21 the primary meeting location. Thank you.
- UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Second.
- CHAIRMAN RUFF: All in favor, say
- 24 aye.
- 25 (Response.)

1 CHAIRMAN RUFF: All opposed? 2 (No response.) 3 CHAIRMAN RUFF: The next item is the approval of the October 5th meeting, which was 5 published on the website. Any updates or changes to If not, is there a motion for that to be 7 approved? DELEGATE KILGORE: So moved. 9 DELEGATE MARSHALL: Second. 10 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Properly moved and 11 second. All in favor, say aye. 12 (Response.) 13 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Opposed? 14 (No response.) 15 CHAIRMAN RUFF: We now have time for public comment. 16 Since the only person I see in the 17 back is Jordan, I'll assume no. Then we will move on. 18 We are delighted that we again have 19 this morning have our acting newly-acting executive 20 director, James Campos. Not compost. I'm bound to do 21 that more than once. I apologize. 22 He comes to us with a lot of 23 experience from several government -- He's work with 24 state legislatures on issues regarding workforce 25 investment, economic development, and education, and

- 1 energy development. So all issues important to the
- 2 Tobacco Commission.
- Welcome. We'll give you a more
- 4 formal introduction at the Full Commission Meeting
- 5 after this.
- 6 The agenda that calls for a
- 7 discussion of compensation, we will not have that on
- 8 the agenda this morning.
- 9 Any other business?
- MR. SORRELL: I didn't have any other
- 11 business, other than the introduction of Director
- 12 Campos.
- 13 CHAIRMAN RUFF: In full disclosure,
- 14 I've been concerned over the last number of years that
- 15 some of our smaller communities have not been as
- involved in the Tobacco Commission, as we believe they
- 17 need to be.
- 18 My concern is that they, either, do
- 19 not community with them properly, or we're talking
- 20 different languages. So I have asked three members to
- 21 act as an in hoc committee to work with the two
- 22 Sara(h)'s and their folks to try to have conversations
- 23 with these counties, and see if we can't make sure if
- 24 we are not doing something right, we are listening to
- 25 their issues, rather than them having to listen to our

- 1 issues.
- 2 Is that a fair summary?
- MR. SORRELL: Yes, sir. I'll add
- 4 that, I guess, November, Chairman Ruff sent out a
- 5 letter to about 20 of our localities that haven't
- 6 accessed programs in recent years, and indicated that
- 7 we would be reaching out to them, and that we would be
- 8 doing some work, proactive outreach, to find out what
- 9 projects are going on in the communities, but also
- 10 making sure they are aware of our current programs,
- 11 and that they are up to date on what our grant cycles
- 12 are and things of that nature.
- Now, I will say that our regional
- 14 staff does a great job of connecting with the folks.
- 15 Sometimes, you know, with a changeover of staff and
- 16 things, things sometimes get lost, and to what
- 17 programs might be a good fit for a particular project.
- 18 So I'm looking forward to jumping
- 19 into this task in the new year. And I was hoping to
- 20 get a little more done in December, but preparing for
- 21 this meeting took my attention away. We will make
- 22 sure -- I think Chairman Ruff was interested in having
- 23 the action of Ms. Dunn.
- 24 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Thank you.
- 25 Any there any other members that want

- 1 to bring up any issues?
- DELEGATE MARSHALL: Yes,
- 3 Mr. Chairman. I would like to put on the table that
- 4 we look at reinstating a stand-alone Ag Committee.
- 5 Members here, look Page 10 and 11 from the Southside
- 6 Economic Development. We had a project there
- 7 yesterday from Virginia Cattleman's Association that
- 8 was assigned to Southside, but it also included
- 9 Southwest.
- 10 I think that Ag, at least in my part
- of the state, Ag in Pittsylvania County is the Number
- 12 1 industry, and in the state is the Number 1 industry.
- 13 I think that sometimes that would, putting them in
- 14 economic development, it doesn't quite fit.
- Just for the Southwest boys and
- 16 girls, I just want y'all to understand that, if you
- 17 look on Page 11, there are several projects there that
- 18 we are funding that are actually in Southwest
- 19 Virginia.
- So we are going to need an IOU from
- 21 y'all to get that money back.
- DELEGATE BYRON: Mr. Chairman, I
- 23 second that.
- DELEGATE MARSHALL: Here's one for
- 25 Russell County, Wythe County --

- 1 DELEGATE KILGORE: Just go ahead and
- 2 give us your credit card.
- 3 DELEGATE MARSHALL: Mr. Chair, I
- 4 think we might want to look at a stand-alone Ag
- 5 committee in the future.
- 6 CHAIRMAN RUFF: I'm not a hundred
- 7 percent sure why we did away with the g Committee. I
- 8 think that's a legitimate point. And I think maybe as
- 9 we go through the strategic update, that might be the
- 10 time to deal with that.
- 11 DELEGATE KILGORE: I think we were
- 12 getting a lot of applications, and I think that is why
- 13 it was all combined with one. The Ag was combined
- 14 because we weren't getting enough applications, but
- 15 Danny has to do it.
- MR. SORRELL: Mr. Chairman, I'll be
- 17 happy to address that for a moment, if you like.
- 18 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Please.
- MR. SORRELL: The ideal time to
- 20 address that would be part of the strategic planning
- 21 process. That's good timing, because we are going to
- 22 have Strategic Planning Committee meeting directly
- 23 after this meeting.
- 24 If you note in your strategic plan,
- 25 that is where we talk about our committees and the

- 1 particular structures of that. I think part of the
- 2 reason they were combined was to just simplify things
- 3 so that projects that were occurring in Southern
- 4 Virginia, whether it was agribusiness or
- 5 infrastructure, or something of that nature for staff
- 6 committee, which make a good point, and just covering
- 7 the footprint, and perhaps there is some other option
- 8 that needs to be considered.
- 9 That is a good point. Thank you. I
- 10 just wanted to let you know the strategic plan meeting
- 11 is taking place.
- 12 DELEGATE MARSHALL: I'm not sure
- 13 whether Danny made a motion or he bade a statement.
- 14 But there was a second. Whether there is a motion.
- 15 It was a statement.
- 16 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Properly moved ane
- 17 seconded.
- Any further discussion on the issue?
- MR. SHELTON: We look into this
- 20 further, or we do this? What are we voting on?
- DELEGATE MARSHALL: I think,
- 22 listening to Andy, I think strategic plan is getting
- 23 ready to have a meeting, and they're going to make a
- 24 recommendation.
- 25 CHAIRMAN RUFF: So the motion is that

- this be referred to strategic planning.
- DELEGATE MARSHALL: Yes. We have
- 3 some people with their arms half up. Or are you just
- 4 resting?
- 5 MR. FOSTER: I wanted to say
- 6 something, but I totally agree with what you're
- 7 saying. If we can get enough applications to justify
- 8 it, which I think we can.
- 9 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Any further
- 10 discussion?
- 11 MR. SHELTON: Chairman Ruff, one
- 12 thing while we have this on the table, is probably to
- 13 be considered is, in my tenure of working for
- 14 Bedwith (SP) when the Agribusiness Committee was here,
- 15 we had multiple projects that were specific to one
- 16 region or the other.
- Then obviously the one we were
- 18 talking about yesterday was structured, and the plan,
- 19 hopefully, for some of the matching funds is for it to
- 20 be a statewide project. All of that kind of needs to
- 21 be, I guess, considered. We are going to have both.
- 22 We are going to have some that need to blanket the
- 23 whole coverage of both regions, and then we're going
- 24 to have some that are going to be specific to one
- 25 region or the other. So it is not going to be a one

- 1 size fits all probably.
- 2 That is just something to consider as
- 3 it goes before strategic planning.
- 4 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Thank you. Any
- 5 further comment?
- 6 (No response.)
- 7 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Hearing none, all in
- 8 favor, say aye.
- 9 (Response.)
- 10 CHAIRMAN RUFF: All opposed?
- 11 (No response.)
- 12 CHAIRMAN RUFF: All right. Still
- 13 nobody to comment. We'll adjourn this meeting and
- 14 move forward.
- 15 (Pause.)
- 16 CHAIRMAN RUFF: Let me un-adjourn for
- 17 a minute. I did not want to get into the compensation
- 18 of the executive director because James is the acting
- 19 executive director. And I'm not sure that I think it
- 20 is proper to go into a full discussion of that at this
- 21 point.
- But Stephanie tells us we have to do
- 23 something or James doesn't get a check.
- 24 DELEGATE MARSHALL: It only takes one
- 25 person.

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1	DELEGATE KILGORE: We are sorry.
2	CHAIRMAN RUFF: So I would accept a
3	motion to compensate James at the rate of the past
4	executive director.
5	DELEGATE KILGORE: So moved.
6	CHAIRMAN RUFF: There is a motion.
7	Is there a second?
8	DELEGATE MOREFIELD: Second.
9	CHAIRMAN RUFF: Properly moved, and a
10	second.
11	Any further discussion?
12	(No response.)
13	CHAIRMAN RUFF: All in favor, say
14	aye.
15	(Response.)
16	CHAIRMAN RUFF: All opposed?
17	(No response.)
18	CHAIRMAN RUFF: Thank you. Now we're
19	adjourned.
